Dear Ms. Morrison:


I have received your letter and accompanying documents regarding your domestic relations case and various related issues. You believe your rights were violated in the process. You ask this office to review the court proceedings.

Your letter and documents have been thoroughly reviewed in the hope that this office could provide the assistance you requested. However, based on our review, there is no action this office can take on your behalf. The Department of Attorney General has no jurisdiction over divorce matters. Property settlements, visitation, custody and support disputes all fall within the jurisdiction of the family court. It would be improper for this office to intervene in the process by which the courts arrive at their decisions.

Court decisions can only be reviewed or altered by appealing the decision to a higher court. You should discuss this matter with your attorney. Your attorney will be able to advise you whether an appeal would be appropriate in your situation.
