Dear Mr. Hannaford:

Please provide the name and address of the Au Pair agency. I requested this **January 27, 1999** in my letter to Mr. Perakis with no response from you or Mr. Perakis. Provide all doctors and addresses that Ashley has attended. This letter is in reference to custodial parental visitation time. I now request **every** weekend starting this week with confirmation to Mr. Henry's office:

1. February 2, 2001- Friday after school to 7p.m. Sunday.
2. I request an additional 4 days make-up based upon your representations made to Ms. Simms in December of 2000. I would request this to be taken during the Easter 2001 holiday.
Transportation-
 - A. I will pick Ashley up after school.
 - B. You will pick her up at my condo on Sundays 7 p.m.

Mr. Henry's office received your fax January 29, 2001 @ 10:25 a.m with your response to my January 22, 2001 letter. Let me respond to your fax:

(1) "It is up to you to build your relationship with Ashley. I will not force her to see you." No overnight visitation.

- a. You allowed me **2 hours of custodial parental time in 1999.**
- b. June 14, 1999: Your Motion to Restrict Defendant's Summer Parenting Time was reversed and remanded by the Court of Appeals. **NO COURT ORDER FOR COUNSELING PRESENTED**
- c. I had **5 custodial parental days in 2000** Ordered by the Trial Court on September 25, 2000 with 1 day allowed by you on Christmas Eve, **totaling 6 days in 2000.**
- d. The parental "Make-up Time" remains unresolved.

A very detailed visitation schedule was agreed upon and included in the SECOND AMENDED CONSENT JUDGEMENT OF ANNULMENT. At this time, I do not feel that agreement should be altered.
